1	Austria	Philately news 2025 - PostAG	Edelweiss reloaded	<p>The edelweiss is inextricably linked with Austrian culture, and it also holds a special place in philately. Twenty years ago, Austrian Post dedicated a stamp to this rare Alpine flower – and it was no ordinary issue: the country’s very first embroidered stamp, featuring a white edelweiss on a green background. Now the edelweiss makes a return – this time not embroidered, but produced using a new technique: 3D printing. Once again, the Vorarlberg-based company Hämmerle & Vogel is the producer. In this innovative process, a specialised 3D printer applies liquid photopolymer in microscopic droplets through ultra-fine nozzles onto the stamp sheets. Each layer is cured with UV light before the next is added. In this way, the edelweiss blossom is built up layer by layer, complete with printed hairs in varying shades and heights – with the yellow florets at the centre standing slightly higher than the white bracts. The printed flower is soft and flexible, with a velvety feel reminiscent of a real edelweiss. Even the green lettering on the gummed stamp is rendered in relief using the 3D printer.</p>		Edelweiss reloaded
2	Austria	Philately news 2025 - PostAG	St Ann\'s Altar by Wolf Huber, St Nikolaus Cathedral, Feldkirch	<p>An extraordinary fold-out miniature sheet is dedicated to St Ann's Altar, one of Vorarlberg’s most valuable artistic treasures. The St Ann\'s Altar was created in 1521 by Wolf Huber, a painter, draughtsman and master builder from Feldkirch, who is regarded as a leading figure of the Danube School. Produced in his workshop in Passau, it is considered Huber’s main work and represents the transition from Late Gothic to Renaissance. The detailed landscapes and buildings in the background of the altar’s paintings emphasise the solemnity of the religious motifs, while the figures appear in bright, luminous colours. During a reconstruction in 1822, the altar’s side panels were lost; they were only rediscovered in 1953 and, after many detours, returned to Feldkirch Cathedral. In 2005, the St Ann's Altar was finally reunited with its original side panels. The miniature sheet features the central panel of the altar. The closed wings show scenes from the life of Saint Anne, the mother of Mary. When opened, the inner sides reveal episodes from the life of Jesus as well as the Lamentation of Christ, the altar’s main image, which is reproduced on the stamp itself.</p>		St Ann's Altar by Wolf Huber, St Nikolaus Cathedral, Feldkirch

As a fascinating topological figure, the Möbius strip has only one face and one boundary. The stamp design interprets complex mathematical concepts through concise and easy-to-understand illustrations, integrating scientificity, cultural connotation and artistic appeal. It is filled with logical beauty and artistic rhythm, demonstrating the rich implications of mathematics that extend from logical elegance to the mysteries of the universe. Adopting spot foil stamping technology, the stamp uses rich color variations to better present the multidimensionality of the Möbius strip. Under ultraviolet light, the footprints of ants on the design echo the Milky Way at the bottom, symbolizing the process of exploration expanding from the microcosm to the vast macrocosm. 

The stamp employs a centrally symmetrical composition from a frontal, eye-level perspective. It synthesizes the artistic conception of traditional Chinese blue-and-green mineral-color painting with modern graphic design techniques, achieving a balance between fine brushwork and expressive freedom. The design is solemn, elegant, and majestic, showcasing the historical evolution, cultural legacy, and architectural aesthetics of the Beijing Central Axis, thereby highlighting its unique artistic appeal. Produced via combination offset and intaglio printing enhanced with special techniques, the stamp features a dominant golden hue, symbolizing the "golden hallmark" of Chinese civilization. The rich colors interplay with the subtle texture of the paper, which not only accentuates the elegant and refined materiality of the axial architecture but also evokes the deep historical resonance of ancient Chinese building traditions. The principal structures are rendered using intaglio engraving. The meticulously engraved lines bring orderly clarity to the architectural forms, transforming the design philosophy of "ingenuity lies in the details" into a tangible, tactile expression. Furthermore, the stamp utilizes full-color photolithography. Under ultraviolet light, the buildings reveal a complementary background scene, creating a dynamic interplay between the substantive and the illusory, movement and stillness. Beneš Square, featuring the imposing Neo-Renaissance Town Hall on the northern side and a row of historical buildings on the western side. The Neoclassical Neptune Fountain rises prominently in the foreground of the sheet. The Liberec Town Hall, designed by the Viennese architect Franz Neumann, was built between 1888 and 1893. The town’s foothill location affords Liberec a good number of rainy days, which cast the sky and the town hall in dull grey tones. However, as soon as the wind breaks the clouds and sunlight gilds the towers, the town hall shines in such colours that one would not expect from grey stone. On the illuminated façade, the black silhouette of the opposite Neptune Fountain with its railing comes into view. The coins weave between the letters, creating an airy and elegant effect. The simple blue-and-white colour scheme highlights both the clarity of the peace symbol and the texture of the embroidery. 

This system was inscribed onto the Representative List of the Intangible Cultural Heritage of Humanity of the United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization (UNESCO) in 2016. These clay tablets, dating to the reign of Darius I, contain unique administrative records that provide invaluable insight into the political, economic, and social structures of the Persian Empire. Loaned to the Oriental Institute of the University of Chicago in 1935 for scholarly study, the tablets remained abroad for more than eight decades. 



The Chinese New Year officially begins on 29 January 2025 and continues until 16 February 2026. The ten \$1.65 denominated stamps and background design show four snakes intimately embracing and coiling around each other. In Chinese culture, the circular connection of head to tail signifies endless continuity. The vibrant red color represents the exuberance and energy of life, every-renewing. The snakes’ united embrace, reminiscent of a Chinese knot and the kid folk game “Jumping the Four Directions” adds a playful touch while staying true to the times. Each snake with its unique pattern, intertwines to represent the vibrant diversity of the world’s nations, united in harmony. Using minimalistic lines, peace lilies are gently sketched, underscoring the message of unity, friendship, and peaceful coexistence. The tabs to the left of the stamps show the United Nations logo on a gold background.
